

# The Dorchester 'E' PlusBus

If you'd like to visit the Dorchester market, go to the shops or the supermarket – or to simply get out and about, then the new Dorchester 'E' PlusBus could be just what you've been looking for.

### When does it run?

The new service – a trial funded by a Dorset Council grant – runs fortnightly on Wednesdays, picking you up at your door.

## Where does it go?

It starts at Winterborne Stickland at 09:30 then picks up in Milton Abbas, Hilton, Ansty, Melcombe Bingham, Cheselbourne and Dewlish, then drops passengers off in Dorchester.

The return journey departs from Trinity Street at 13:00.

## How much does it cost?

The return fare is £7 (reviewed annually) & National bus passes are accepted.

## Register before booking

To use the service, you'll need to register first. It's free to join and all you need to do is call us on the number below to get things started.

### How to book

To book your place for a particular Wednesday, simply call or email us. Once registered, you can book up to one month in advance but no later than 14:30 on the previous working day.
